You can qualify for 70% DV Tax Credits by making a monetary donation of at least \$100

- You can make multiple **smaller payments** within the year **totalling \$100**

You can make a maximum monetary donation of \$50,000 annually

- Monetary donations include cash, credit card, stocks, gifts of real estates, IRA contributions etc

How to start the process:

Step 1: Make a monetary donation to CADV

Step 2: Once your donation is received, you will receive the application with your thank you letter

Step 3: Return the completed application and supporting documentation to CADV

Step 4: The tax credits can be redeemed up to 2 years — year of the donation and the following year
